Road Closures for the
Shorewood Crossroads Festival Parade

The Shorewood Crossroads Festival Parade will be held on Sunday, August 8, 2010. Staging for the parade will begin around 11 a.m.. The parade will commence at noon from the intersection of Geneva Street and Ravinia Drive. The parade will travel west on Geneva Street to southbound River Road. The parade will turn west on Seil Road and travel out toward the Shorewood Four Seasons Park. Roads intersecting Geneva Street, roads intersecting River Road between Geneva and Seil, and roads intersecting Seil Road between River and the railroad tracks will be closed to traffic between the hours of 11 a.m. and 2:00 pm. on Sunday, August 8, 2010. Residents in the Hunt Club and the Vintage subdivisions will be able to access their neighborhoods on Hunter Drive off of River Road. Residents of Kipling Estates and Lake Forrest subdivisions will be able to access their neighborhoods from River or Mound Roads. Residents of Westfield Village (north of Geneva) will be able to access their neighborhoods from Huntington Drive off of River Road. Ravinia Court and River Oaks West will be able to access their neighborhoods from Seil Roads or connecting neighborhood roads coming from River Oaks Subdivision.
